Dear Mr. Buckman:

Thank you for your letter of July 9, 2009 concerning AT&T's non-compliance with the Cable and Video Competition Law of 2007. As you may know, the Attorney General's office was instrumental in drafting the 2007 Cable law and believes that adherence to its provisions is necessary to bring the benefits of video competition to Illinois consumers.

In connection with our review of AT&T's treatment of Public, Education, and Government programming, we submitted comments on the way AT&T transmits PEG programming to the Federal Communications Commission last spring. Although the FCC has not taken any action to date, we are continuing to gather information to address the problems that you identified in your letter, and to determine the appropriate legal response.

Again, thank you for informing us of your concerns.
